Without love and devotion we will not be able to reach God, says Swami Teonram. Therefore, we should recite the name of God with true love for Him.

*Prem akhar padhe satguru mann sheetal kayo
Sakhi kayain sabh jo chaubade chade ram
Saami nivare sansan chadiyain chin mein*

God will always listen to our prayers and will come to help us whenever we remember Him with true love.

*Vich bediya mein phasi draupadiya pukariyo ho
Achi mithade man mohan tehenjo kasht nivaryo ho
Tu bhi bhora bharam chade bhagwat te bhare dis
Mitho maalik indo aa mann mein tu sambhare dis*



*Sad sahib sunando aa sik saan pukare dis

In mahabharat we read that when draupadi was being hastled, she called for Lord Krishna and He came to save her from humiliation. In the same way we should also give up all our superstitions and remember God: He will definitely come to our rescue.

Our Guru always fulfills his disciples' wishes: the only thing the disciple has to do in turn is to show his true love and devotion for his Guru.

Sik waaran ja sankat prabhu paan to taare dis
Vishwasan ji vipata prabhu paan to taare dis
Mitho maalik indo aa mann mein tu sambhare dis*

Whoever has true faith in his Guru will always be protected by Him. He will always those who come to under His shelter.

In His ambrosial words, Swami Teonramji Maharaj tries to explain to us that the Lord will always listen to the prayers of His disciples who remember Him with true love and devotion. A true devotee will always be able to get the sacred vision of God.

*Prabhu viyapak sarva samana
Prem se hoye prakat main jaana*

Whenever we require help, we will search for someone who is closeby who could help us. If not, we ask someone who is further away by writing them a letter to request for help, but even then we are not guaranteed the help we require. God does guarantee this help as He is everywhere. The Lord just requires a bit of love and devotion from His disciples to be able to help them.

One who prays to God with honesty will always be protected by him; one who gives up everything at the holy feet of his Guru will always be sheltered by Him. We should have true faith in God as only then will we be able to reach Him.

*Paar braham to nikat hai, door khoj mat tahn
Kahe teon bhitar mile, bahir milat na kahn*

God resides inside us, therefore He can reveal himself in no time. When we need him only we have to pray with our love and devotion for him. When we worship god he does not see what we have brought for him in our hands he only sees what we have inside our heart for him

whether we have love and devotion for him or not. Even if we place one flower at his sacred feet with true love will be accepted by him .

Sant sheva mein sudh budh so bhulji vayo
Nai banaji prabhu tehenjo karj kayo
Pehenje bhaktan jo thiyoo sada rakhpal aa*

Sainu nai was a barbar who was at the service of his king. The King suffered from leper and hence Sainu used to massage him to relieve the king from such pain. One day when some saints arrived to the king's palace, Sainu forgot the king and began to serve the saints. He did not think that the king could be angry with him as he had left his duty. God came to Sainu's rescue and dressed up in the form of Sainu he stood at the service of the King whilst Sainu served the saints. From this, we see that whoever prays to God with true love, He himself will always help him.

*Jadehn purab janam jo bhaag tho khule naseeb tho khule
Tadehn santan sajan jo satsang tho mile*

God always fulfills the prayers of His disciple. Saint Tulsidas was also able to gain the sacred vision of his Guru. Meerabai and Kabirdas were also fortunate to obtain the sacred darshan of their Guru. In the same way, Swami Teonramji Maharaj was also blessed by His Guru Dada Aasooram .In every era God is present, so we should not think that we will not be blessed by our Guru .God will always be with us as long as we show our love and true faith in him. Whenever there is lack of justice on earth, a holy saint is born to bring peace and love on earth.

Our mind is incapable of understanding many things and our knowledge is not complete, but having love and devotion for the Lord will help us understand the messages our scriptures try to put across without having to actually read such scriptures. The love for God which resides in the hearts of disciples brightens the flame of knowledge inside. That is why our Guru says that love is above everything in this world.
